New Academic Year 2019-20.



The school were re-opened on 3rd of June throughout Tamilnadu for the new academic year of 2019-20. On the very first day Headmaster of our school introduced our new correspondent Rev Fr David Nesan. Then we started the day with Eucharistic celebration. This year

we have a reasonable number of admissions. The total number of students are 684. Out of this the total number of boys are 356 and the girls are 338.

Examination Results

We are indeed very happy to share that on 19th of April the government of Tamil Nadu published 12th standard results and our school got 97%. And XI standard students result 100% and our 10th standard result is 79%. We congratulate all the staff and faculty who worked for this achievement.

Appointment of New Teachers

Teachers are the driving force of the students who play an important role in bringing them up and making good citizens of the nation. Our school always stands firm in providing adequate teachers for all subjects, so that no students should lack of teachers for any subject. This year we have appointed five new teachers for various subjects.

appointed for his practical training. Girls Wardens Ms Kalaivani and Ms Juliet and boys warden Mr Samson and Mr Premnath.

CHEER trust centre is a centre for various purposes. In the month of May Rev Fr John Suresh gave cultural training on various arts and theatre. Students and youths have enthusiastically participated in the training. At the end of training all the participants were given certificates.

Dear friends and well wishers, I am S. Priya from Kolathnallur a village, near to near to Neerpair village. My father name is Mr Sekar. Who is working as gardener in our St John's Home for the children in Need, Neerpair. Many of you might have seen him while you visited in Neerpair home. I have two brothers who were also supported by WE group like me. My parents were illiterates.

I had my school education in Dr R Arulappa higher secondary school, where I got partial fees concession with the help of Fr John Suresh and Ms Nandhini Akka. After my school I joined Sri Santhoshi Collage of Arts and science where I did my Bachelor degree of Business Administration (BBA) with the help of Fr John Suresh and Nandhini Akka through WE group.

After my collage studies I got married to a person with whom I was in love. I have put all my trust in him but soon everything gone vain. At the beginning the life was well, later only I understood or he showed his real nature. He started to persecute and beat me even for simple things. He treated not as wife but as a slave. When I resisted this he was so furious and acted vigorously, which I was not able to tolerate any longer and I left him to live a dignified life instead of being slave to him. Soon after some days he eloped with another girl. I have a child which I got through him with me. I take care of all the needs of my child.

Now I am working at St Joseph's Matriculation higher secondary school, Porur. With the help of WE group and Fr John Suresh I am doing my part time Post graduate degree in Business Administration (MBA). I stand on my own leg taking care of my child and also taking care of my parents. In our Indian society if a girl is given in marriage, she has to be with her husband even if he is cruel or arrogant only few girls who take bold decision to come out of such situation to have dignified life. The education I received and the awareness trainings that I received through our WE group helped me to take a bold decision for the better future of me and my child.

On this occasion I sincerely thank all our friends, benefactor especially our Pappa Dr Johannes Mispagel, Rev Fr John Suresh, Nandhini Akka, who played an important role in moulding my life. Had I not received education and being a part of our WE group, I would have not even thought that I will have a dignified life even after unsuccessful marriage with the man.
